Joining

The members of the co-operative are the students and teachers who have promoted the creation of the co-operative and have applied for it to be registered with the EJE CENTRAL CO-OPERATIVE REGISTER.

Each one of the members must contribute to the share capital. The said contribution will commit the members to achieving the objectives and the respect the rules set out by the cooperative.

Organization and responsibilities

Co-operative members are responsible for management tasks. Members from the General Assembly. The members present at the assembly constitute the quorum.

The members present at the assembly elect the representatives who will form the co-operative's board of directors.

These people will implement the decisions made by the co-operative members and they will be accountable to all members at subsequent meetings.

The chairperson, the secretary and the treasurer have the authority to sign documents on behalf of the co-operative.

At the end of the course, an annual activity report will be submitted to the assembly.

Share capital

The co-operative's share capital comprises all the contributions made by the members.

In order to become a member, each person must contribute 2€

Once members have paid their fees, they will receive a document certifying they are member. The ownership of the share cannot be transferred.

Paying the initial contribution is a necessary condition but not sufficient to be entitled to any reimbursement or the distribution of only surplus.

Reimbursement of the share capital

The reimbursement of the share capital will take place at the end of the course, once all the cooperative's debts have been paid.

Meetings

Ordinary meetings will be held every once a month. Extraordinary meetings can be called whenever co-operative members consider they are necessary. A meeting will be valid if 50% of the members + 1 are present.

Length of the activity

The co-operative will be considered active from the moment it applies for registrations in the EJE CONTROL CO-OPERATIVE REAGISTER and will cancel its actives when the course finishes.
